BRIEFING NOTE: "Sexual Exploitation" in the Global Fund's Codes of Conduct

The Global Fund has established Codes of Conduct which employees, resource recipients, suppliers, Country Coordinating Mechanisms (CCM) members, and governance officials must uphold while carrying out their work. One of the requirements, which applies to all parties under these codes, is to prohibit "sexual exploitation." Due to widespread conflation of sex work with "sexual exploitation," however, there is concern that this provision may be misinterpreted to exclude sex workers. This Briefing Note clarifies this provision and provides information which members can use if they are challenged by Global Fund stakeholders.

Understanding the Global Fund's Codes of Conduct

The Global Fund's Codes of Conduct outline the requirements and expectations that employees, resource recipients, suppliers, CCM members, and governance officials must meet. Among these provisions is the requirement to "prohibit, prevent, and respond to" sexual exploitation. The Global Fund defines "sexual exploitation" as:

"... any verbal or attempted abuse of a position of vulnerability, differential power, or trust, for sexual purposes, including but not limited to, profiting monetarily, socially or politically from the sexual exploitation of another."

This definition also takes from the UN Secretary General's 2005 definition of "sexual exploitation" which was given in response to an investigation into the "sexual exploitation" of refugees by aid workers in West Africa. While the definition in itself does not exclude sexual exploitation with sex work, it may be subject to misinterpretation due to ambiguity and widespread conflation of sex work with exploitation and trafficking. This link is screenboxed when no attempts are made to distinguish sex work as a form of labour.

Briefing Note: Sexual Exploitation In The Global Funds Codes Of Conduct

This briefing note clarifies the Global Fund's provision to prohibit 'sexual exploitation' in its Codes of Conduct, explaining how it should not be conflated with sex work and should not be interpreted to exclude sex workers.

Why is a written report important?
The main goal of the CLAIM project is for networks of people living with HIV to coordinate civil society, build policy recommendations together and to advocate for these in Global Fund processes and other national decision-making spaces. The policies that you advocate for must be clearly defined and written out in a format that can be understood by decision-makers. The best way of doing this is to develop a joint civil society report that brings together all your advocacy demands in one place.

Report template
When you fill in the template to include in the report and come to what to do in each...
Introduction: Write a short description of who you are and the process that you followed to arrive at your advocacy demands. It is important to introduce your organization and to include a list of all the groups and other organizations that were involved in the consultations and the key populations in health areas that the report is for (e.g. TB, malaria, people who use drugs, young people).

Background information: Briefly describe the situation in your country, including any information relating to specific problems that you wish to address. This section should not be too long, a couple of paragraphs are enough. Try to include the answers to some of these questions:
➤ Which populations are most affected by malaria, TB or HIV in your country?
➤ What current policies / laws are in place to help?
➤ Do you have an up-to-date national AIDS strategy?
➤ Are there any particularly successful interventions that have been shown to work?

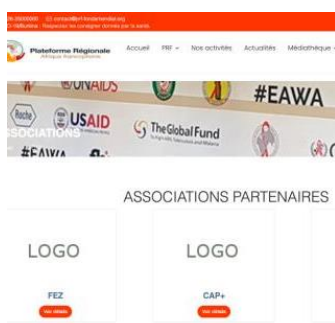

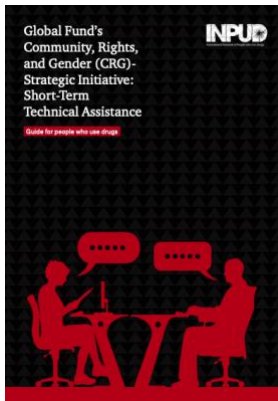

Opportunities for women to influence the Global Fund in your country

This newsletter has been developed specifically to ensure that Women's Global Fund (W4GF) Advocates are accessing Global Fund Community, Rights and Gender Strategic Initiative Technical Assistance (TA). We hope to see more women in all our diversity accessing TA in line with the Global Fund's Strategic Objective 3: "to promote and protect human rights and gender equality". Accessing TA from the Global Fund is easy and this is what you need to know.

1. What might it mean for you?

W4GF has played a substantial role in increasing women's meaningful participation in CCMs and the understanding and awareness of women and gender on these important country-level structures. When W4GF was launched, just 8% of CCMs had members who either represented women or who were gender specialists and advocates. By 2017, the share had risen to 40%. This improvement is due in large part to advocacy efforts by W4GF and allies to get the Global Fund to make and better enforce requirements for women's engagement and representation on all CCMs.

Accessing TA can be a key part of your efforts to be strategic, organized, inclusive and representative, including by being a source of financial assistance to support the participation of a diverse group of women (including adolescent girls and young women) in national Global Fund processes. So - if you have not already applied for TA then you should.

The Global Fund is committed to supporting the meaningful engagement of women in Global Fund related processes and throughout the funding cycle so that communities can meaningfully engage in Global Fund-related processes.

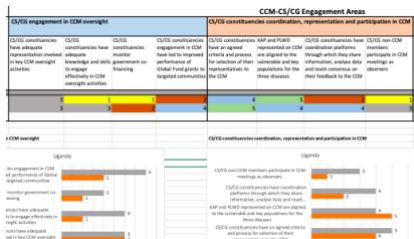

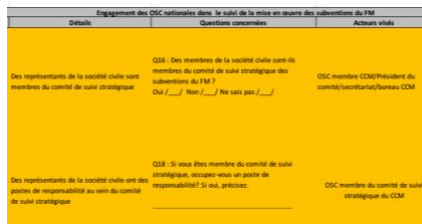

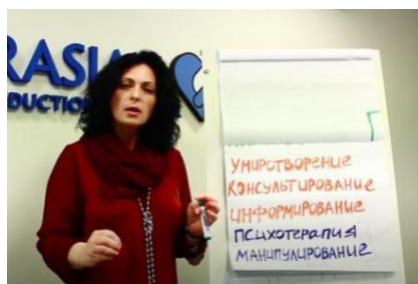
